

JAPANESE MAGNOLIA

Reed Diffuser Safety Precaution Information

Read safety information carefully before use.

Directions of use

- 1. Unscrew and remove seal from the top of the bottle.
- 2. Screw the cap back onto the bottle.
- 3. Wash your hands after handling.
- 4. Insert the reed stems into the bottle making sure you spread out the stems.
 - i) The reeds will act like a wick drawing up the fragrance and releasing it into the air.
 - ii) As the reeds absorb the fragrance they will become deeper in colour.
- 2) Ensure the diffuser is placed on a stable surface to prevent accidental spillage.
- 3) **DO NOT** place on polished, painted or plastic surfaces.
 - i) Wipe surface free of any spillage.

Lasts approx. 12 weeks

PRECAUTIONS FOR USE/SAFETY INFORMATION: Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood. Avoid breathing vapour or dust. Wash hands and other contacted skin thoroughly after handling. Contaminated work clothing should not be allowed out of the workplace. Avoid release to the environment. Wear protective gloves/eye protection/face protection. IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. IF exposed or concerned: Get medical advice/attention. If skin irritation or rash occurs: Get medical advice/attention. If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention. Take off contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Collect spillage. Store locked up.
