Reed Diffuser Safety Precaution Information

Read safety information carefully before use.

Directions of use

- 1. Unscrew and remove seal from the top of the bottle.
- 2. Screw the cap back onto the bottle.
- 3. Wash your hands after handling.
- 4. Insert the reed stems into the bottle making sure you spread out the stems.
 - i) The reeds will act like a wick drawing up the fragrance and releasing it into the air.
 - ii) As the reeds absorb the fragrance they will become deeper in colour.
- 2) Ensure the diffuser is placed on a stable surface to prevent accidental spillage.
- 3) **DO NOT** place on polished, painted or plastic surfaces.
 - i) Wipe surface free of any spillage.

Lasts approx. 12 weeks

PRECAUTIONS FOR USE/SAFETY INFORMATION: Keep out of reach of children. Wash hands and other contacted skin thoroughly after handling. Avoid release to the environment. Wear protective gloves/eye protection/face protection. IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Do not induce vomiting. If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention. Collect spillage. Store locked up. Dispose of contents/container to approved disposal site, in accordance with local regulations.
